



## **APPLICATION PACKET 2010-2011**

### **I. APPLICATION PROCESS**

Thank you for considering Pope John Paul II Academy for your child's education. PJPA has a selective admissions policy. Below please find our Admissions Policies, Financial Information, and Application Form. Please read all documents thoroughly so there will be no misunderstanding on the part of parents or students about the expectations of the school.

We encourage you to submit your application materials as soon as possible, as demand for seats is high. We do review academic information, and often ask prospective parents and students for interviews, so the earlier you submit this application, the sooner we can begin the process.

You will be notified of our admissions decision by the first week of February 2009 and in some cases, considerably sooner.

### **II. ADMISSIONS POLICIES**

Pope John Paul II Academy is a lay-owned and lay-operated Catholic school that features a classical curriculum. It is incorporated under the laws of the State of Louisiana and is a registered 501 (c) (3) non-profit organization. The Academy offers grades PK4-12.

PJPA is "provisionally approved" as a new nonpublic school according to the State of Louisiana, and is a candidate for accreditation from the National Association of Private Catholic Independent Schools. Its credits are, therefore, recognized by the State, other schools, and all colleges, just like any private school that has been open for many years.

Pope John Paul II Academy admits students of any race, color and national or ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, color and national or ethnic origin in the administration of its educational policies and athletic of other school administered programs.

At this time, however, Pope John Paul II Academy does not have the personnel or the facilities to address the needs of children with serious emotional or behavioral problems, or the needs of those students with serious learning disabilities that require special programs.

### **III. TUITION PAYMENT RATES AND POLICIES**

Tuition for the 2010-2011 school year is as follows:

Pre-K4	\$5,350
Grades K-4	\$5,250
Grades 5-8	\$5,800
Grades 9-12	\$6,300

All fees (registration, books, supplies for Grades K-6, and basic field trips) are included in the tuition figures, with the exception of the new family fee of \$300 per student/\$500 maximum per family.

Tuition is due in full on July 1, 2010. Families may elect to pay over ten months; the installment plan fee is 1.5% of tuition.

### **IV. MULTI-STUDENT DISCOUNT PROGRAM**

An enrollment deposit of \$500 per child is payable when this application form is submitted; this deposit will be deducted from the total tuition owed.
